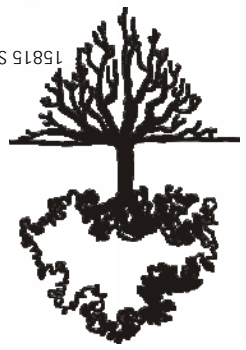

Important stuff to know...

When: Thursday to Monday, July 29-August 2. Meet in the Church parking lot at 11:30 am to load up. The buses will leave around 12:00 pm on Thursday and return around 12:30 pm on Monday.

Where: Camp Firwood's South Cove beach property located on Lake Whatcom just southeast of Bellingham, Washington. South Cove provides a beautiful waterfront beach, boat dock, playing fields, dining facilities, campsites, a campfire pit, and more.

How Much: \$225 covers everything at camp, including an awesome camp t-shirt. Students will want a few dollars for camp store snacks (i.e. ice cream, pop, candy, etc.). **Partial scholarships** are available for families or students who need assistance. We would encourage everyone to take advantage of the Scrip Program to earn money towards Safari. Contact Rene in the student ministry office for more information or assistance.

Who can come: Summer Safari is for students entering 6-8th grades next fall. Friends are always welcome - bring them along!

What is there to do at Safari?

What do I bring to Safari?

A final information sheet will be sent to you a week before camp with a detailed packing list and any other important information. Basically, you will need: a sleeping bag, pillow, towel, casual clothes, a sweatshirt or jacket for evenings, swimwear (one-piece only), personal care items, a Bible, journal, pen and a flashlight. **About modesty - we ask that all students attending camp dress in a modest fashion.** For ladies, no short shorts, low-cut tops, spaghetti strap tops, bikinis/tankinis (or you will need to wear a t-shirt over your swimsuit at all times), micro-minis, etc. For guys, no saggy or low-riding pants/shorts, please make sure your underwear doesn't show. We will be doing lots of outdoor activities that require you to sit on the ground - casual, comfortable clothing is in order.

Conditions of Enrollment

1. Refunds of camp fees are not made for any campers departing early from camp for any reason, including health.
2. The Crossroads Bible Church (hereafter CBC) reserves the right to dismiss any camper who constitutes a hazard to the safety and/or rights of others or demonstrates that he/she has rejected CBC rules and the reasonable controls and supervision of the camp staff. **NO REFUND OF CAMPER FEES WILL BE AVAILABLE.**
3. The CBC reserves the right to refuse any camper for whom he/she feels the camp cannot provide adequate health care for and/or supervision, out of concern for the camper's health and safety. CBC also reserves the right to refuse any camper who we feel is unable to understand and/or follow safety procedures.
4. Conditions of custody, if applicable, will be fully communicated in writing to CBC, including a photocopy of the section of any order referring to visitation rights.
5. Failure to disclose medical problems or concerns at the time of registration could result in dismissal.
6. The parents/guardians are responsible for replacing property damaged by the reckless behavior of the camper.
7. CBC is not responsible for lost or stolen property. Valuable items should not be brought to camp.

I/We (parent/guardian) specifically agree to the following:

1. To permit our camper to be involved in all activities at Safari - any restrictions have been noted on this registration or an attached sheet.
2. To release CBC and any of their affiliates, officers, directors and agents from any and all civil liability arising from my child's participation in Safari.
3. CBC staff may search my camper's luggage if necessary.
4. Permit the use of photos and videos or other pictures of my camper in promoting CBC programs.
5. My signature on this application shall give the CBC authorization to arrange for any special services or other requirements necessary for my child's welfare and good health including ordering injections, anesthesia, or surgery, if I cannot be reached.
