...In Team 3

Team 3 is an energetic, fun-filled program focused on Scripture memory and application. Team 3 happens on Wednesday evenings from September through April. Serving in Team 3 is an eight month commitment and there are several ways you can serve.

Department Leader

The Department Leader coordinates and facilitates communication for the volunteer team of a particular age group.



Time Commitment

- 2 hrs. Wednesday evenings.
- Potentially 2-5 hours of team coordination and communication during the week.
- Relevant Training Events.
- September - April.



Responsibilities

- Pray for each volunteer on your team.
- Communicate with Team 3 Coordinator to effectively guide program and assist with changes or needs.
- Facilitate teamwork during program.
- Facilitate program schedule.
- Be available to answer volunteer questions.
- Communicate appropriate information to volunteers.
- Administer discipline as needed.
- Oversee and direct during program activities.
- Facilitate drop-off and pick-up process.



Must be a MEMBER of CBC

Chapel Leader

The Chapel Leader presents stories to support understanding of Scripture verses and their application.



Time Commitment

- 2 hrs. Wednesday evenings.
- 30-60 min. of preparation time during the week.
- Relevant Training Events.
- September - April.



Responsibilities

- Pick up lesson materials from Department Leader.
- Prepare provided stories in advance.
- Present stories in a dynamic, engaging manner.
- Interact with children as topic allows for questions or responses.



Must be a MEMBER of CBC

Small Group Leader

Small Group Leaders guide group members through participation in each event and help members understand and apply the verses they learn.



Time Commitment

- 2 hrs. Wednesday evenings.
- 30 min. of preparation time during the week prior.
- Relevant Training Events.
- As needed for special events or parties.
- September - April.



Responsibilities

- Pray for each child and family in your class.
- Pick up lesson materials from Department Leader.
- Prepare for each class in advance to interact with the children in a meaningful way.
- Arrive in assigned room 15 min. before program start.
- Accompany children to and from all activities.
- Participate with children in all events.
- Administer discipline as needed.
- Review verses with each child.
- Stay with group until parents picked up.

Worship Leader

The Worship Leader engages children in praise and worship through songs and movement.



Time Commitment

- 2 hrs. Wednesday evenings.
- 30 min. of preparation time during the week prior.
- Relevant Training Events.
- September - April.



Responsibilities

- Prepare age appropriate songs in advance.
- Facilitate worship atmosphere that encourages both fun and respect.
